Mr. Tarushka, Chair, called the meeting to order at 8:05 p.m.; the clerk called the roll.

Present: Mr. Balanoff, Mrs. Hess, Mrs. Lambert, Mrs. Miller, Mrs. Meehan, Mr. Paone,
Mrs. O'Neil, Mrs. Quigley, Mr. Tarushka, Mrs. Zerba, and Mr. Stokinger.

Mrs. O'Neil opened the meeting with a request for actual student enrollment in each school rather than the student increases.

Mrs. Miller commented on the lack of community members attending the budget hearing. She saw only school administrators attending.

On a motion by Mrs. O'Neil and seconded by Mrs. Hess;

Voted: To recommend Article Three, the 2005-2006 Operating Budget

Passed: 9 Approved, 1 Opposed

On a motion by Mrs. Quigley and seconded by Mr. Paone;

Voted: To recommend Article Two, Bond for the Ventilation System

Defeated: 3 Approved, 7 Opposed

On a motion by Mrs. Quigley and seconded by Mrs. Miller;

Voted: To recommend Article Four – Kindergarten Classrooms

Passed: Unanimously

A discussion ensued regarding Article Six. It was stated that Dr. McDonald wanted a petition article because the need wasn't brought up until the budget process was completed. If this article is defeated, by law, the district cannot spend any budget money to repair the track.

On a motion by Mrs. Zerba and seconded by Mrs. Quigley;

Voted: To recommend Article Six – Track Renovations

Passed: 9 Approved, 1 Opposed
