Delegations and individuals

Ms. Deb Rose, Sandown resident and Sandown North food service worker spoke as a representative of the Food Service workers of the TRSD. Ms. Rose recapped the current food service program and distributed to the Board a package outlining her statement as well as lunch schedules and a letter from the Department of Education complimenting the program. A discussion ensued relating to equipment, space issues and the wellness committee. Mr. LaSalle thanked all the food services workers for sharing information about the program; noting this was an opportunity for the district to review the food service program and its options. Mr. LaSalle stated he would like to see the following goals in place for any food service program that is put in place: improve facilities, a (POS) computer system, and coordination with the wellness committee.

Student Council

Emily Weston reported that spring sports are under way but are facing some difficulties with practices and upcoming game schedules due to the current weather. Many teams have been forced indoors for practice times.

The Timberlane Players have scheduled their spring production for this weekend of One Act Plays. Students will perform "Love, Death and Elevators" on April 5, 6 and 7th, scheduled at 7pm, with a 3pm matinee on Saturday.

Timberlane hosted the NH Destination Imagination Competition this past weekend. The TRHS team came in fourth in their category, and elementary teams did very well also, with the Danville Elementary team placing second in their category. Danville will now have the chance to attend the National Competition in Tennessee later in the spring.

Ms. Weston also reported the Student Council is working hard, with a hectic few months coming up. Kids Night Out is planned for this Saturday, April 7th; there are still openings available for the evening events. Next week will be the start of the Penny Wars amongst all four classes in the high school. Student Council will also be selling wrist bands

which will allow students to wear Red Sox hats for a day, or teachers to dress down in red sox apparel. Proceeds from this event will go to the Jimmy Fund. On April 17th, the council will host a regional conference for the four other schools in the region. The theme will be Community Service, with a focus on cancer and helping to support those around us who may suffer from cancer, or who have family or friends suffering from the disease.

Current Business

Pollard School/Plaistow Old Home Day

Mr. Brian Levasseur requested approval to use the Pollard School property for Plaistow Old Home Day events. The proposed events this year may include a moon walk, high striker, rock climbing wall, slide and an obstacle course. The Old Home Day Committee would provide the certificate of insurance naming the Timberlane Regional School District and the Town of Plaistow as named insured. The moonwalk, slide and obstacle course are inflatable while the rock-climbing wall will have a safety harness. The boy scouts will be cleaning the area once the events have ended. The TRSB would like to review a list of rides once the decisions are made by the Old Home Day committee. Mr. Levasseur will provide this list to the TRSB.

Substance Abuse Prevention

Tim Lena and Kelly Binette presented students Monica Fuller and John Balanoff Jr. who reported on the many activities of the SAP (Student Assistance Program). They described the positive impact Herb Levine's presentation and Rachael's challenge was for the students. Mr. Lena presented the past years data survey and notified the board that the 2007 survey will be published soon. Mr. Lena and Ms. Binette thanked the board for their continued support and described some of the programs that are available to the students.

Crabtree Report

Mr. LaSalle noted that a plan needs to be in place for the Food Service program of the TRSD. The plan program should have:

- Current program improvement
- Point of service computer system
- Food service staff working with the district wide Wellness committee
- Continuous improvement plan

Mr. LaSalle suggested implementing a kitchen improvement plan; it should be a five-year plan to effectively utilize \$100,000 per year from the food service program for maintenance and improvements to the program and equipment.

Some repairs and improvements are not as expensive as others. An example would be storage; it would be inexpensive and cost effective to improve storage. The service area at Pollard will need immediate attention while issues at the high school could be addressed on an ongoing basis.

Food Service RFP

Mr. LaSalle reported that currently two companies are interested in the operation and management of the food service program. The Crabtree report will be shared with these companies.

The district has an opportunity to review the entire Food Service program at this time and should do so by sending out the RFP (request for proposal) and coordinating the advertisement for the Food Service Director's position. A discussion ensued.

Title 1 Report

Mrs. Ralph informed the Board that the Department of Education reported TRSD is in full compliance of the Title I program. After a review of Sandown North, Pollard and Danville schools by the DOE where consultants reviewed, interviewed and observed tutors, teachers, etc., one recommendation was received - the DOE recommended a small change to one form which has been done and submitted to the state.

NEASC Report

Submitted to the Board was Mr. Ronald Edmiston, Chairperson of NEASC Leadership and organization committee requesting the board's input on the interaction of the High School principal, Superintendent, and the School Board in their decision-making and other administrative functions. Dr. McDonald agreed to submit a response on behalf of the Board.

School Board Goals

The 2007-2008 school years goals need to be created. Members were asked to review the previous school year goals and they will be discussed at another meeting.

Timberlane Regional School Board meeting schedule

A discussion continued regarding the Atkinson Academy project, concern was expressed by the board as to whether the bidding process was necessary for all vendors and what affect would the bidding process have on the time line of the project.

Summer Schedule

Mr. Hughes recommended a summer four-day work week scheduled for the Board's consideration. It was noted that last year approximately \$30,000 was saved in electrical and mechanical run time when this schedule was used. The schedule will include extended hours per day, to allow for a four-day work week.

Sandown Central and Pollard will allow summer recreation programs to use their facilities as needed during the summer months.
