Current Business

Delegations and Individuals – Kelsey Janowicz, Student Council member reported on the upcoming Spring Concert and the All State Festival. Kesley noted the first place winner of the Battle of the Bands that was held on March 29th was the band “All is Well”. Kids Night Out turned out to be a fun night for all that attended. Nine members and two chaperones attended the Student Council Conference in Atlanta. All the members enjoyed exploring the city and meeting people from around the country. Mrs. Champey thanked Ms. Janowicz for her reports.

Kelley Binette, MSW – TRMS TSP Program-8th Grade Lock-in

Kelley Binette introduced students, Valerie Stein and Kevin Sukovich who reported on the Tip, Save and Peer Mediation Group also known as TSP. The 8th grade students would like to host a “Lock-in” event in the spring. This is a Sober Fun event that provides a fun atmosphere for students to have a good time, substance free in a closely supervised setting. A discussion ensued.

Atkinson Academy Fields and Parking Lot

Whereas, Mr. Stewart, Atkinson Road Agent was not able to attend this meeting, Mr. Stokinger conveyed his understanding that fill is being offered to the town of Atkinson by the Route 111 project. Mr. Baldwin noted proposed work at the Atkinson Academy Elementary School field was started prior to approval and is now an eyesore. He has concerns regarding erosion and noted a type of manhole cover on the property where the trees have been recently cleared; he would like clarification of this manhole cover. It was noted that we have no choice but to fill the land to prevent any erosion but additional information is needed to further discuss this issue.

The agreement discussed previously regarding the Atkinson Academy Elementary School field was understood to maintain the current field space not any enlargement of the field space. The district’s attorneys are reviewing the agreement; this issue should be on the next TRSB agenda.

Facilities Report

Mr. Stokinger reported on the following facilities projects:

- TRHS
 - There are catch basins at TRHS and TRMS that could be eroding and are marked by construction cones; we will investigate this issue and report back to the TRSB.
- Danville Elementary School
 - The Danville Elementary School boiler failed this week, emergency repairs were completed and it is now working.
- Pollard School
 - One of the new boilers was replaced without question at the Pollard School when it did not respond properly.
- Atkinson Academy
 - The leaching field in the front of Atkinson Academy has failed; it was constructed on or about 1971 and is fed by three tanks. On Friday 4/7/06 it will be inspected, we anticipate that a new septic design will be necessary. The estimated cost will be approximately \$25,000 to replace the three tanks and if necessary, expand the leach field. Currently some bathrooms at Atkinson Academy have limited use due to this situation. Senter Brothers are licensed installers of septic systems and are available to do necessary work as soon as possible.

On a motion by Mrs. Miller, seconded by Mr. Luongo

- **Voted:** To waive district policy to allow Senter Brothers to complete necessary work on the leach field at Atkinson Academy.
- **Passed:** Unanimous

NECAP

Joan Griffin and Keith Pfeifer presented the district results of the New England Common Assessment Program 2005 of grades 3 through 8. The No Child Left Behind Act requires states to annually measure proficiency in reading and mathematics for all students in grades 3-8 and in grades 5 and 8 in writing. The testing was done in fall of 2005. Writing and reading scores are good but we will continue to improve on these results. This year new curriculum materials were introduced in grades 1 through 8, which should result in improved scores. It will take some time to see the full effect of this instruction.

It was noted that all test scores are being evaluated but all aspects of Sandown tests are reviewed. Student accommodations were discussed and a lengthy discussion ensued. Dr. McDonald noted that the state website is available to view all tests results.

2006-2007 Calendar Draft #3

The Board reviewed draft #3 of the 2006-2007-school calendar. Once adopted by the TRSB the calendar will then be sent to the commissioner for final approval.

Summer Hours

Mr. Hughes proposed a four-day workweek during summer months to save energy costs. He estimates approximately \$11,000 can be saved by working a four day workweek, Monday through Thursday, ten hours per day, if a sick day is used it would count as 1.25 days. Mrs. Withee suggested a one-year trial during the summer months with monitoring of energy costs to verify actual savings. Then present the findings to the TRSB for future consideration. Mrs. Aubrey thanked Mr. Hughes for his creative suggestion for saving energy.

Administrator's Report

Dr. McDonald reported Ellen Beckwith received the Fulbright Scholarship and will spend 10 days in Japan. Timberlane Schools and the SAU are participating in the Next Step Wellness program. Mr. Farrell of Plaistow requested using Pollard School for a voting facility. A meeting time was set up with Mr. Farrell for April 13 at 11:00 am at the Pollard School.

Personnel Reports

Dr. McDonald informed the TRBS that Mr. Johanson notified him of his intention to retire on June 30, 2006. He explained that search committee should consist of two school board members, students, parents, special education employee, teachers, secretary and Mr. LaSalle.

Committee Reports

Mrs. Kosta noted the dropout bill (raising the dropout age from 16 to 18) was passed to the house. Mrs. Withee and Mrs. Aubrey attended the Facilities Committee meeting. Mr. Stack informed the public the Curriculum Committee's next meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, April 12 at the TRMS. They will be discussing NECAP results, block scheduling and the proposed kindergarten committee. Mrs. Miller inquired about the committee assignments. Mrs. Champey explained the committee assignments were not finalized as yet. Mr. Brown attended the Budget Committee meeting and reported that Charles Balanoff is the Chair and Elizabeth Quigley is the Vice-Chair. Mrs. Suech expressed her concern for low voter turnout she believes, is because schools was not in session on Election Day. The committee would like to have joint budgetary meetings with the TRSB this coming year.

Mrs. Champey attended the Facilities Committee meeting, reviewed the arsenic level test results that were done due to the change in requirements from 50 parts per billion to 10 parts per billion. Pollard and Atkinson both register .1 or .2 above the limit. We are currently investigating resolutions for this issue. Summer projects are being reviewed which include Sandown Central storage shed, TRHS garage expansion, maintenance department training and accountability as well as the kitchen audit. The next scheduled meeting is at 8:30 am on May 16 at the SAU. Mrs. Champey also thanked Mrs. Withee for accepting the Facilities Committee Chair position. Mrs. Miller discussed the Committee Relations and Liaison committee, which met once; she is hoping other board members from each town, parents, Superintendent and Selectman will attend the quarterly meeting.
