Assistant Principal News

We have had a busy start to the year. Teachers have been evaluating students through district assessments in order to create instructional groups and set targeted goals for all students. They are continuing to implement district adopted curricula while utilizing our new rubrics to review student work for evidence toward competency. A flyer was sent in your Danville Delivery recently about parent information sessions on the new K-5 Elementary Report Cards. This is the first of many opportunities to gain information or ask questions. Sessions are not school specific, anyone can attend.

Our first STAR assessment results have been sent home. This test is a computer-adaptive test which provides information for instruction relative to student needs, both for intervention and enrichment. Teachers will be discussing the first STAR benchmark and any progress monitoring completed over the next few weeks at parent teacher conferences in November. However, please reach out with

any questions you would like answered before that.

Day 1 and 2 Blizzard Bags are coming home!

It is only October, but we are prepared for any reason school may be canceled. To know for sure that a day has been designated as an Online Learning/Blizzard Bag Day, listen to the "No School" alert message. The message will indicate that it is an Online Learning/Blizzard Bag Day rather than a traditional snow day. During an official Online Learning/Blizzard Bag Day, your child's teacher (in grades 3-5) will be online to view, comment, and support students during the hours of 10:00 am - 2:00 pm. Your child's teacher (in grades K-2) will be available through email between the hours of 10:00 am - 2:00 pm to answer any questions you have.

Students in grades K-2, and those in the upper grades with the paper copy option, are asked to bring their work to school the next day. We want the Online Learning/Blizzard Bag Day to be a great success. It is important that all students participate. In order for the day to count as a school day the district needs 80% participation. It is our goal at Danville Elementary to have 100% each Blizzard Day.

The goal of these lessons, is to teach students the skills that strengthen their ability to learn, have empathy, manage emotions and solve problems. Your children will be learning a lot this year and he or she will need your help! Look for tips and updates in the monthly newsletter to help understand what your child is learning. 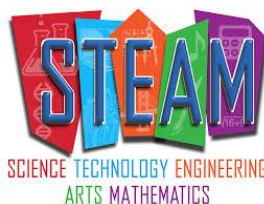

The kindergarteners have enjoyed many science experiments since school began. We observed the reaction between two chemicals, vinegar and baking soda, to see an apple explode. In another experiment, we observed what happens when you add water to a circle of Skittles; the Skittles "rainbow". We've hypothesized whether apples would sink or float and then tested our theories. Our greatest experiment so far was dissecting acorns; each student used scientist's tools (a magnifying glass and tweezers) to take apart an acorn and look inside. We are currently trying to grow a maple tree from an acorn in the Innovation Lab.

The fourth and fifth graders started off the year brainstorming a list of expectations for working in groups in their respective classes. Their first challenge is underway, with groups of three or four designing and building a piece of footwear out of newspaper and tape. The winning shoe will be worn by me for an entire day to show it off! The students are being quite thoughtful with respects to my comfort, the durability of the shoe, and my sense of style!

All About Art!

Dear Danville Families,

We are busier than ever in the Art Room this year! All students have been working on a piece of art that will participate in an all school fundraiser that has been done in the past called Original Works of Art. More information about this fundraiser to come. The Pre-School and Kindergarteners are working on creating a Caterpillar. They are using their tracing skills and they are practicing their coloring skills. Kindergarteners are also practicing their basic shapes.

The First Graders are working on a Fish illustration. They were told a silly story while they drew their fish using basic shapes. The focus of this project is on patterns of line, shape and color.

The Second Graders are working on illustrating a tall stack of teacups. The focus is on overlapping shapes and creating patterns with lines, shapes and colors.

The Third Graders are creating Owls. They learned some new facts about Owls. The focus of the project is on overlapping and using patterns of shape, lines and color.

The Fourth Graders are creating Celestial Suns. They learned about how different cultures over time viewed the sun as a symbol and/or a God. The focus is on symmetry, and patterns using line, shape and color.

The Fifth Graders are working on creating Lighthouse scenes. They learned some facts about lighthouses and saw many visuals of them. I taught the students the basic structure of drawing a lighthouse and then we talked about the foreground, middleground and background of their landscape.

I am collecting appropriate, child friendly magazines for collage pictures at this time. Other recycled materials are also being accepted for three-dimensional building. We do not need newspapers at this time.
