It has been a very busy start to the school year. Students have enjoyed getting to know their new teachers, classmates, and classroom spaces. With that being said, here are the three school goals we will be focusing on as a school to help ensure that students make academic and social-emotional growth:

- 2) By June of 2023, 80% or more of all grades K-5 students will achieve annual typical growth according to i-Ready Math proficiency measures.
- 3) Throughout the 2022-2023 School Year, Danville Staff will offer students differentiation and social/emotional learning centered around the 5 CASEL Competencies - self-awareness, self-management, social awareness, relationship skills, and responsible decision making.

Danville Elementary is a special place where the respect, responsibility, and pride of our Hawkes truly shine through. We are eager to further develop our relationships with students, staff, and families this year, and excited for the learning and growth ahead.

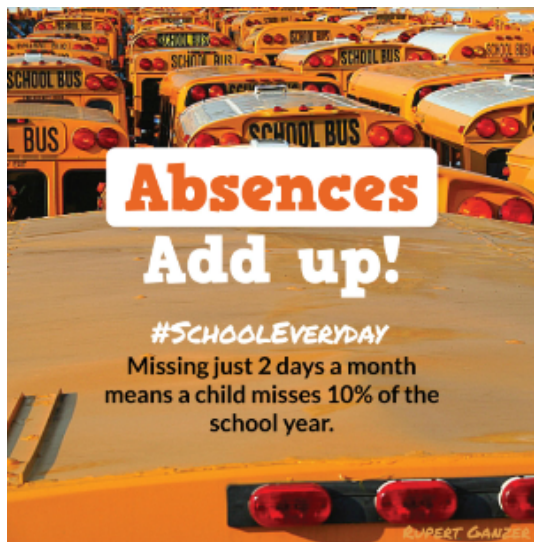

Attendance Policy

We ask that you contact the school prior to the start of the school day (8:30 am) if your child will not be attending school. To provide for the security of your child, school absences that are not reported to the school will be followed up with a phone call from the office. If necessary, the person listed as an emergency contact will be called. If the school is still unable to ascertain the whereabouts of your child, the Danville Police Department may be called to conduct a wellness visit to ensure the child's safety. However, it is the parent's primary responsibility to make the call to the school. The attendance line is available 24 hours a day at 603-382-5554 or you may report the absence through the Pick Up Patrol website. Any student arriving after 8:30 am must enter through the main entrance with a parent or guardian and check in at the office before reporting to the classroom. If you need help setting up your Pick Up Patrol account, please call the office for assistance.





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School Safety: A copy of this brochure was sent home in the Danville Delivery in September. Please take time to review the various safety drills that are conducted throughout the school year. To date, we have completed multiple Fire Drills, Clear Halls, and Door Check drills. We anticipate completing an Evacuation Drill within the next two weeks. This drill is always done in conjunction with the Danville Police and Fire Departments.

Reverse Evacuation

A reverse evacuation will be used for a danger on the playground. An adult in charge will signal the students to line up quickly and enter the nearest door. The office will be notified and attendance will be taken.

Shelter in Place

A shelter in place will be called when students need be housed in one place (such as a smoky forest fire). We may use this procedure to dismiss from one location. Attendance is taken to ensure the safety of all children.



Secure Campus

In the event of a threat outside our school, all students will be kept inside, outdoor activities will be cancelled, exits will be checked and classroom activities will continue as normal.

The Crisis Team at Danville Elementary School practices emergency management procedures to follow in the event of an emergency at our school. Common language helps your child remember how to stay safe in an emergency. This is the language we use at Danville Elementary School.

Evacuation

If we have to leave the school in an emergency situation, we will call an **evacuation**. The students will leave the school in an orderly fashion, attendance will be taken once safely away from the school, and we will walk to the evacuation location. Parents would be notified of the event and where to pick their child/children up. Please be prepared to provide identification.

Fire

The fire alarm will be activated in the event of a **fire** at the school. Students leave the school and attendance is taken to ensure all students and adults are accounted for.

The fire and police department personnel will determine if it is safe to return to the school or if an evacuation must be conducted.

Vocabulary

Please help our children stay safe by using this language when you talk about the drills we have here at school.

Lockdown

In the event of a danger within our school, a **lockdown** will be called. During a lockdown, students will stay in their classroom and follow the directions of their classroom teacher.

Door Check

If a student tries to leave the building without permission, staff will stand in front of exits until the event has ended.

A Drill

A drill is what we practice in the case of an emergency.



Drop, Cover, and Hold

In the case of falling objects or high winds, students and staff will face away from windows, drop to the floor, and get under a sturdy table or desk and hold on.

Danville Elementary School's Crisis Team is made up of administration and staff devoted to keeping the children in our school community safe.
