

News from School Counseling

February, school counselors met with all students to review their course selections for the upcoming 2022-23 school year. Counselors will be reviewing student schedules in late spring and schedules will be posted in PowerSchool in August. If you have any questions about your student's course requests, please reach out to their counselor.

During the first week of April, school counselors met with students from the junior class to discuss post-secondary planning. They discussed the college search process including college visits, application deadlines and testing information.

Counselors also reviewed Naviance and the helpful tools that are offered through this platform. Naviance is a college and career readiness software providing college planning and career assessment tools to partnering high schools.

On April 5th, seniors and their guardians were invited to a Financial Award Letter and Paying for College" seminar hosted by a NHHEAF representative and the Director of School counseling Barry Chooljian. This seminar was held virtually allowing parents/guardians and students to participate from home.



The SAT testing day for all juniors will take place Wednesday, April 13th. Juniors are already registered for this test through the school district and state, no additional registration steps are necessary. Email

communication was sent to all juniors and parents/guardians on March 21st. Additional information will be provided through email.
