

Dear Seniors and Parents/Guardians:

The SAT with Essay will be administered to seniors on Wednesday, October 14th at the high school as part of state testing for New Hampshire students. Seniors are already registered for this test through the school district and state, so no additional registration steps are necessary for students.

For families / students that do not wish to participate in testing, we have attached an exemption form to opt out of this testing. Please return this signed form to the high school counseling office or email it to us at the email included on the form by October 2nd so we can properly prepare for testing.

The SAT School Day testing with Essay is approximately 3 hours and 50 minutes of testing for the standard administration. For students already approved for extra time accommodations we will communicate directly with those students about their testing times on the 14th as well as the 15th, if they require two days of testing.

Students will transport themselves to school on Wednesday October 14th and arrive at school at 7:20. Testing will be completed for most students by 12:30.

Specific testing locations and additional testing details will be forthcoming to students.
