To help you with this process, guidance counselors will be holding Common App Work Sessions in June, and again in August, to help you get started and to answer any questions you have on the Common App. We will offer this support as well when school is back in session, but why wait? Attendance for Exams

In order to create a successful exam-taking environment, unnecessary distractions and interruptions must be kept to a minimum, therefore students must be on time for all of their exams.

Tardiness to exams will not be tolerated. If a student arrives late to an exam, the student will be prohibited from taking the exam and must make alternative arrangements with their teacher. Alternatively, if a student is absent for an entire exam day, the student will need to make arrangements with their teachers as soon as they return to school

Late Arrivals and Early Dismissals

Late arrivals and early dismissals during exams will follow procedures similar to a normal school day. Students arriving late for school must enter through the Front Office and **will need to have a signed note from a parent/guardian.**

Students that are going to be dismissed early must have a note with their first and last name, the time they are being dismissed, and a parent or guardian's signature. **Only students with signed dismissal notes will have permission to leave school.** Students who leave without a dismissal note will be subject to the appropriate discipline.

Seniors and Juniors who have late arrival and early dismissal privileges must follow the same procedures as a normal school day by signing-in and signing-out in the Front Office.

Study Halls and Lunch/Studies

Study halls and lunch/studies will run during Finals. Students will report to their study classrooms for those exam periods. Students will be able to catch up on missing/late school work or study for upcoming exams in a quiet atmosphere. There is no exam for study halls or lunch/studies.
