School Counseling News

December 9th marked the halfway point of second quarter and progress reports were emailed to parents on December 16th. Please let Guidance know if your email address has changed. You can also view your student's academic progress on your parent Powerschool account. If you need assistance, please call the Guidance Office.

Seniors are reminded to keep their grades up since colleges will be receiving mid-year grade reports to review with their applications. Thirty-eight percent of our seniors are already awaiting college decisions, and some have already been accepted for Fall 2017! Keep up the good work Seniors, we love hearing about your success. Please see your counselor if you need help with the application process or are looking to forge a plan for the future.

Now is also a good time to be checking the scholarship listing on Naviance as we are receiving information on new scholarships every day. Seniors are advised to submit applications for scholarships they seem to be a match for, and for the Timberlane High School Scholarship application. The Timberlane application is now available and a completed application will make applicants eligible for over 40 local scholarships. Other scholarship resources are posted on the Guidance page on our website.

On December 5th we began the post high school career and college planning process with our sophomores. Counselors met with all 10th graders in the library computer lab to introduce students to Naviance Succeed, our college and career readiness software program. Students completed a Career Interest Profile and Career Cluster Finder, and learned how to use additional features such as College Match. Students identified three careers they were interested in and this list will be used when inviting speakers for Sophomore Career Day to be held on April 18th. Sophomore parents are invited to attend our **Sophomore Parent Night** on January 17, 2017 at 6:30 PM in the Cafeteria for an introduction to the Naviance software program, career surveys and early college planning tips.

PSAT scores were posted to student's College Board accounts on December 12th. Students can upload their results to Kahn Academy for targeted personalized practice for future SAT testing. Students also received a paper copy of their score report. If you have any questions please call the Guidance office.
