| Athletic Council Trust Scholarship               | Selected by committee. Seniors who play a sport and who are in good standing.  |

| John Bourdelais Memorial Scholarship             | Selected by committee. Senior attending a 2-year college in field of technology or special education.  |
| Leigh Buckley Memorial Scholarship               | Selected by Language Department using applications. Senior who has taken Spanish while in high school for a minimum of three years.  |
