#### WHAT IS PROJECT NAVIGATION?

Project Navigation is a day-long event, filled with relevant workshops that  $7^{th}$  graders and their families often encounter. The day is geared towards gaining information as we head into the 2018 - 2019 school year.

### WHAT ARE MY WORKSHOP CHOICES?
