#### Hello and Happy October,

The staff and students have been settling into a nice school routine. It's hard to believe we're already beginning the 6<sup>th</sup> week of the school year. Thank you to everyone who participated in the PTA Fall Fundraiser. It was extremely successful. Families and staff purchased a total of 655 mums! All proceeds support the Sandown Schools. If you haven't already joined PTA, I would encourage you to do so. PTA meetings are opened to parents and are held on the first Monday of every month from 6:00-7:00pm at one of the schools. The PTA posts the location of each month's meeting on the PTA Facebook page.

As we move into the school year, I wanted to send a reminder about sending food into the school for birthday celebrations. All snacks must be wrapped in the original container that contains a list of ingredients. Please see Nurse Megan's message below for further clarification. As an alternative to food, a small trinket or pencil can be sent in for each child.

All district elementary schools as well as TLC will be holding Halloween Parades on Monday, October 31. The district understands that this year, Halloween falls on a day when Preschool and Pre-K are not in session. Parents of students in those grades are welcome to bring their students to school and walk with them in the parade. The parade will begin at 10:15 with kindergarteners leaving the building through the front entrance and walking around the building twice. Parents can park in the parking lot (overflow parking is at the library) and watch the parade. Kindergarten parents should send their student to school in their costume. No masks or weapons please. Parents should pack a large trash bag for transporting the costume home, and a change of clothes. This will prevent any damage to costumes when students attend recess and P.E. If teachers are planning other activities, they will communicate to families directly. October 9<sup>th</sup> through October 15<sup>th</sup> is Fire Prevention Week. This year, our Pre-K and Kindergarten classes will be taking a walking field trip to the Sandown Fire Station. There, they will meet with fire officials and learn about how to stay safe in a fire emergency. Please keep an eye out for permission slips this week. Sign and return the permission slips as soon as you receive them. Parent teacher conferences will be held on October 20. Conferences again will be offered via zoom. Many teachers will be using sign up genius to schedule conferences. All staff are looking forward to talking with parents about their child's progress.
