### Philosophy

The Timberlane Regional School District is committed to the development of skills in the core areas of English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies and Social Emotional Learning. Our Kindergarten teachers administer programming based on TRSD aligned PK-12 curriculum. Highly qualified teachers employ age appropriate methodologies and activities that highlight hands-on, discovery learning and active engagement.



### TRSD Kindergarten Options

#### Option 1: Full-Day Kindergarten

TRSD offers tuition based\* Full-Day Kindergarten. Students receive daily instruction in core content areas, participate in lunch and recess, and attend one Unified Art per day (Art, FLES, Music, PE, and Technology). Transportation for Full-Day Kindergarten is provided to and from school.

#### Option 2: Half-Day Kindergarten

TRSD offers free Half-Day Kindergarten in a morning or afternoon session. Students receive daily instruction in core content areas, including FLES. The District provides **one way** transportation for half-day sessions (to school in the a.m., from school in the p.m.). Parents are responsible for all mid-day transportation.

**Please contact your home school for sessions available this year.**

**Full-day Kindergarten classes will be limited to 20 students.**

**If the number of applications exceed the maximum number of students for a class, a lottery will be held to determine placement. Families will be notified if a lottery needs to take place.**

\* The total annual cost is \$4500. The cost may be paid in full or it may be paid in 10 monthly payments of \$450 each beginning August 1, 2020.

## Registration

The New Student Registration process will be ONLINE and opened on February 1st.

**In addition to the online registration process, families must also bring to the school:**

-  **Original birth certificate with raised seal**
-  **A completed Certification of Residency form**, located online in the New Student Registration process
-  **Qualifying Proof of Residency** →
-  **Immunization Records with updated vaccinations**
-  **A Physical exam dated September 1, 2019 or later**

**One** of the following qualifies:

- Two current utility bills (separate utilities)
- A mortgage statement
- A purchase and sales agreement
- A lease with one utility bill
- A property tax bill
- A property deed
- Certificate of Occupancy Permit

*\*Children must be 5 years old on or before September 30<sup>th</sup>.*

**Additional Information needed if applicable:**

- ★ Proof of custody and/or parenting plan in a divorce, separation, or non-marital situation
- ★ Licensing papers for a foster home
- ★ Name of adult responsible for medical and educational issues of any student residing with a relative
