Conditions include but are not limited to, inclement weather, emergency operations, facilities issues, etc.

To the best of our ability Distance Learning Days will be anticipated in advance so that students bring their one to one devices home in preparation of these events.

Distance Learning Days By Level	
Preschool, Pre-K, and Half Day Kindergarten	Families will be notified via email and/or online platform of all live sessions scheduled for instruction, and attend any virtual sessions their teacher(s) assigns. Parents will receive materials through email or students will use the platform shared by their teacher (SeeSaw or Google Classroom) to access all activities and practice of lessons delivered.
Full day Kindergarten - Grade 5	Families will be notified via email and/or online platform of all live sessions scheduled for instruction, and attend any virtual sessions their teacher(s) assigns. Students will use Google Classroom to access all other activities and practice of lessons delivered.
Middle school Grades 6-8	Students will follow the schedule of the day as if it were an 'in-school' day. For example the day will continue to be an 'A' day or 'B' day based on the planned calendar. Students will attend classes virtually based on a 'normal' school day schedule.
High School Grades 9-12	Students will follow the schedule of the day as if it were an 'in-school' day. For example the day will continue to be an 'A' day or 'B' day based on the planned calendar. Students will attend classes virtually based on a 'normal' school day schedule.
