## **TRSD Pre-K Options**



### AM Pre-K at your home school

TRSD offers tuition based\* AM Pre-K. Students receive instruction in early literacy and early numeracy, as well as participate in explorative play, structured teacher-led centers, and snack. Transportation can be provided **to school**. Parents are responsible for all mid-day transportation.

#### Alternative Options

#### TLC @ Sandown Central Only: PM Pre-K

TRSD offers tuition based\* PM Pre-K at TLC at Sandown Central. Students receive instruction in early literacy and early numeracy, as well as participate in explorative play, structured teacher-led centers, and snack. Parents are responsible for transportation to and from school.

#### TLC @ Sandown Central Only: Peer Partner Program

TLC offers a Peer Partner Program\*\* which follows the hours of 9:00-11:30 Monday, 9:00-3:10 Tuesday-Thursday, and 12:40-3:10 Friday. Participation is based on a screening process. #### Tuition

\* The total annual cost is \$2200. The cost may be paid in full or it may be paid in 10 monthly payments of \$220 each beginning August 1, 2021.

\*\* The total annual cost for peer partners is \$2700. The cost may be paid in full or it may be paid in 10 monthly payments of \$270 each beginning August 1, 2021.

In addition to the online registration process, <u>NEW families to the district</u> must also bring <u>to the school</u>:

 Qualifying Proof of Residency ----->
Original birth certificate with raised seal
A completed Certification of Residency form, (located online in the New Student Registration process)
Immunization Records with updated vaccinations
A Physical exam dated September 1, 2020 or later

\*Children must be 4 years old on or before September 30<sup>th</sup>.

#### Additional Information needed (if applicable):

**One** of the following qualifies:

- \* Two current utility bills (separate utilities)
- \* A mortgage statement
- \* A purchase and sales agreement
- \* A lease with one utility bill
- \* A property tax bill
- \* A property deed\* Certificate of Occupancy Permit
- Please note any utility must be connected to the physical location of residence, a cell phone bill does not apply.
- ★ Guardianship documentation is required in any circumstance in which a student does not live with his/her parent(s) (foster documentation, guardianship documentation, court placement).
- ★ Proof of custody and/or parenting plan in a divorce, separation, or non-marital situation
