Dear Parents of Preschool Children,

As you may be aware, the Timberlane Regional School Board has approved moving the Timberlane Learning Center Preschool Program (TLC) from Pollard Elementary School to Sandown Central School beginning in the 2015-16 school year. We are very excited about this opportunity to grow our preschool program, and to expand on the array of educational experiences currently offered at the TLC Pollard location. All regular education tuition paying students who requested placement in the TLC preschool program are guaranteed a space; however, the location of that placement will be determined based on availability.

The district continues to operate half-day preschool classes at Atkinson Academy, Danville and Pollard Schools. As has traditionally been the case, these early learning environments will have a limited enrollment for regular education students. So, we are very excited to be able to offer additional opportunities at Sandown Central for those children not admitted to their neighborhood school program. Parents interested in enrolling their child in the Sandown Central Early Learning Center Preschool Program should notify their building principal no later than Friday, June 12<sup>th</sup>. All other regular education students will be entered into a lottery for available building-level openings and notified of placement decisions by Friday, June 19<sup>th</sup>. Any students not placed in their neighborhood school program will still have an opportunity to enroll at the Sandown Central location.
