Funds may be used to address learning loss, prepare schools for reopening, and inspection, testing, maintenance, repair, replacement, and upgrade projects to improve the indoor air quality in school facilities, including mechanical and non-mechanical heating, ventilation, and air conditioning systems, filtering, purification and other air cleaning, fans, control systems, and window and door repair and replacement. We are required to set aside 20 percent of the funds to address learning loss and provide mental health services and support among students.
