Isolation separates sick people with a contagious disease from people who are not sick.

Quarantine separates and restricts movement of people who were exposed to a contagious disease to see if they become sick.

*A number of variables determine specific start and end dates to isolation/quarantine periods. School nurses will help identify these.

** School nurses will provide information regarding your student's return to school.
