

Tips for Using Google Classroom with TRSD Google Apps for Education

Chrome should be the web browser used to get the best results. When you shut down your computer, it updates automatically. You will need to have the latest version of your web browser to use Google apps for education. *Examples of web browser are: Microsoft Explorer; Mozilla Firefox; Safari, and Linux.*

You can download **Chrome** for free. It is owned by Google, so it works best with Google Apps for Education, although it is not necessary if you are up to date with browsers.

Using Google Classroom on your mobile device.

If you are using a laptop or desktop computer, you will see the icon for Google Classroom and Google Apps. You must be signed in to your gapps account. If you have another Gmail open, you must sign out.

Classroom app for Android

If you want to access Classroom from your Android device, download the Classroom app from Google Play.

1. Touch **Google Play Store** on your device.
2. Find and install the **Google Classroom** app.

Classroom app for iOS

If you want to use Classroom on your iPhone® or iPad®, download the Classroom app from the App Store.

1. Touch **App Store** on your device.
2. Find and install the **Google Classroom** app.

What can students do with the mobile app?

Students can post to the class stream, view, complete, and turn in assignments, and view their assignment planner. They can also join classes and contact you or other classmates.

To use all the features of the Classroom app, you need Google Docs, Sheets, and Slides as well. If they aren't already on your device, you can get them from the Google Play Store (Android) or iTunes® (iOS).
