

Dear TRSD Families,

April 9, 2021

I would like to thank you for all of your continued support as we have successfully made the transition into 5 days a week in-person learning for most of our students. We will continue to offer remote options and accommodations for our staff and students until at least the end of the 2020/2021 school year. In order to be able to be successful in staying in this in-person model, I'd like to take this opportunity to remind students and their families of a number of important items to ensure that we will be able to successfully stay in the in-person model.

-If you or your children are attending any sort of public event (sports, hobbies, social gatherings, etc.) we strongly encourage you to continue to adhere to health and safety guidelines of pre-event health screening, social distancing, mask wearing and proper hygiene. Although TRSD cannot control these outside organizations, we do ask that you help prevent the spread of COVID and take all precautions to ensure the health and safety of yourself, your family, and the entire TRSD community.

-Please help us protect the health and safety of the entire TRSD community by reminding your child to:

- Wear their masks properly in all district buildings (except when eating). Masks **MUST** cover both the mouth and the nose to be effective.
- Stay socially distanced of at least three feet at all times (even if they are wearing a mask).
- Stay socially distanced of at least 6 feet if they are not wearing a mask to eat or on a mask break.
- Monitor at home daily for any signs and symptoms of COVID-19 as described in the [TRSD Daily Screening Form](#), stay at home if need be and contact your child's school nurse if they have any signs and symptoms.

Please note that Wednesday April 14, 2021 will be a remote school day for Grades 9,10 and 12 at TRHS. Grade 11 students will be in person to take the state mandated SAT school day exam.

Please note that Friday April 23, 2021 will not be a school day for all PreK-12 students due to the second vaccination clinic for district employees.
